#### **YBA April Newsletter 2023**

I think I hoped for a less soggy and cold month as clubs opened their doors to the 2023 season at the start of last month's YBA Newsletter... well that worked didn't it?!! Still it has to get better soon. The start of any season is usually a challenge with greens on the 'pushy' side and layers of clothing needed to keep warm but critically we are back on our greens and bowling.

# Safeguarding

Very soon all the talk will be of forthcoming matches whether in leagues, competitions or social bowling and that's what we should be focussing on. However, there are some things that also need to be thought of, ensuring we have a safe environment for all is one such issue that all clubs need to pay attention to. David Dearlove is the YBA Safeguarding Officer and he is the point of contact for you all as our National Governing Body, Bowls England (BE), issues guidance on just what all clubs need to be doing in this important area:

- All coaches are currently required to be qualified coaches and to have attended a Safeguarding Course, they also need to hold an Enhanced DBS Certificate which has been obtained via BE.
- All team managers are currently required to have attended a Safeguarding Course and hold an Enhanced DBS Certificate which has been obtained via BE.
- All Safeguarding Courses have to be completed via an accredited provider.

Note: Whilst a DBS Certificate has no official expiry date, it is BE's policy that they should be updated every 3 years. Enhanced DBS checks have to be obtained through the National Governing Body i.e. BE or the EIBA. There is an option to have an annual automatic update which is FREE of charge for volunteers. Please note that BE will no longer accept DBS certificates from any other source e.g. scouts, church, other sports — or certificates older than 3 years.

It will become <u>compulsory</u> and a <u>condition of affiliation</u>, for all clubs to have a Safeguarding Officer by **the beginning of the 2025 season**. They must attend an accredited Safeguarding Course and have an Enhanced DBS Certificate via Bowls England.

# Coaching
