



This is a picture of Town Street Methodist Chapel. Also known as Tip Chapel. The little hut next to it was used for the Junior Sunday School. It was at the junction of The Street and Town Street. Town Street has since become Crown Street. There are different opinions on why it was known as Tip Chapel. Some locals say that, when the railway was built there were a lot of Irish workers that lived at Town Street and a popular song they sang was 'It's a long way to Tipperary' so, the locals shortened it to Tip. Other locals say it's because the municipal tip was at that end of town.
