

OVERNIGHT TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER, A350 HIGH STREET, SPETISBURY

DORSET COUNCIL has issued an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. The Order comes in to operation between 20:00 until 06:00 on 27th September 2021 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 9th October 2021.

This Order will enable Dorset Council to carry out carriageway maintenance and resurfacing works.

The effect of this Order is as follows:

[1] To impose a temporary road closure on A350 Spetisbury from a point 40 metres to the north of West End to a point 130 metres to the south of South Farm Road (in both directions), an overall distance of approximately 1030 metres. A signed diversion will be in operation which will go via A350, Roundhouse Roundabout, A31, Bere Regis Roundabout, A35, Northbrook Roundabout, A354 and vice versa.

[2] To impose clearway and parking suspension as indicated by signs on site to prevent waiting or parking on A350 Spetisbury from a point 40 metres to the north of West End to a point 130 metres to the south of South Farm Road (in both directions), an overall distance of approximately 1030 metres. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by this Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
