## BSJ COMMUNITY SPEEDWATCH UPDATE - OCT 2022 (MARIE PERRY)

The Speed Indicator Device (SID) data Apr 22 - Sep 22:

- Incoming: 52,658 vehicles of which 27.22% are doing
  >30mph as they enter the village
- Outgoing: 40,853 vehicles of which 48.99% are doing
  >30mph as they leave the village
- Highest recorded speeds leaving the village: 83mph (Friday 10th June 8pm) and 75mph (Sunday 12th June 10am)
- Highest recorded speed coming into the village: 69mph (Friday 2nd Sept 4.30pm)
- Regular speeder c.5.30am weekdays >50mph

**CSW Sessions:** 

- > 40 watches so far this year
- > Total vehicles counted = 1,311
- > Speeders = 71 (5% of total recorded)
- 5 excessive speeders (>45mph) 50mph highest recorded speeder (entering the village)
