- (a) 18/501130/FULL 2 Cedar Cottages, Sheephurst Lane
 Erection of a single storey side extension with the insertion of 2 no. roof
 windows.
 Cllrs wish to raise objection on the grounds that this is a further extension on a
 previously extended cottage under application MA/11/0192 and MA/13/0667
 which cumulatively results in harm to the character of the surrounding open
 countryside, contrary to Policy SP17. Cllrs also wish to add that the overall
 design and specifically the width and incongruous hipped roof and velux
 windows of the proposed extension would result in harm to the character of the
 existing dwelling contrary to Policy DM30.
- (b) 18/501134/LBC Pond Oast, Tanner Farm, Goudhurst Road
 Listed Building Consent for changes to previously approved interior layout
 (reference 14/0346)
 Cllrs noted although Cllrs express some concern about the fire safety of the
 internal voids and emergency egress from the proposed new bedrooms in the
 roundels, whilst not a development control matter, would recommend seeking
 early building control advice.



(c) 18/501365/TNOT56 – Land at New Marden Cricket Club

Installation of 20 metre high telecommunications monopole with 3 no. antennas, 4 no. transmission dishes and associated ground-based equipment cabinets. An existing floodlight will be removed from the application site as part of this proposal
