Residents Correspondence:

General:

While there are a few remaining documents to upload and some fine tuning to take place the new website for Uffington Parish Council related items is now live and can be found at www.uffingtonparish.gov.uk. The Vale of White Horse District Council has withdrawn the Joint Local Plan proposal which was proposed in conjunction with South Oxfordshire District Council. It is unsure what effect this will have regarding reviews of local Neighbourhood plans at this time.

It has been advised by the approved contractor that the tree works agreed at the Parish Council meeting (09/25.12.3) would be completed during October/November.

There are currently a number of allotments available. A publicity campaign has started to promote the awareness of availability.

There are a number of road works planned for the coming months although due to the installation of the Gigaclear infrastructure some of these may need to be delayed to avoid duplication and clashing of work requirements.
