

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO7369) affecting Malthouse Lane from its junction with Barley Close for 80m eastwards in the PARISH OF CANTLEY, LIMPENHOE AND SOUTHWOOD to facilitate communication pipe repair works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 23rd to 25th January 2024 for the duration of the works expected to be about 3 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Malthouse Lane, Burnt House Road, Manor Road, Station Road, Langley Road.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
