He persevered going from site to site in 1991 and eventually, with help from Ray Malpass, obtained a lease in November 1991 from the Aylesbury Sports Company on land where, in 1988 an indoor bowling green had been proposed. Then followed the process of getting a few other people to take on specific tasks to obtain enough information to present details to a public meeting of bowlers in December 1991. The first public meeting was an eye opener to most of the local bowlers in that the Gang of Four produced an enormous amount of data and positive results in those 3 weeks. The ace was a Solicitor of wide experience in the setting up of a bowls company being a bowler herself and having done exactly the same with her own bowls club. The combination of the Gang and an experienced Solicitor gave the local bowlers the necessary encouragement to invest in the proposed project. However, the big shot in the arm for the project was the enormous support given by the William Harding Trust and local bowlers of all ages will forever be grateful to the Trustees. Many who might have made a grant to the club did not do so which means that members must shoulder a large bank loan. Obviously a bank was needed to grant a loan but it was now larger than originally planned and whilst most banks showed some interest it was only Barclays who saw the potential in the project and were prepared to back the Gang of Four in the first place and subsequently The Directors. The finance was on the way and membership was growing but shareholders were and still are needed. The Directors have a large commitment to the bank in terms of a guarantee but we bowlers are indebted to a few of them who have also dug deep into their personal resources to provide substantial amounts of money for the club.

The Gang of Four were all important to the project bearing in mind before the company was formed they were personally in debt to the tune of many thousands of pounds each with the possibility at that time that the project would not get started. When they wavered, and they did, it was Andrew who rallied the gang. Nothing will please Andrew and the Gang more than to see all local bowlers enjoying the facilities for which they have fought so hard.

In the Vale of Aylesbury and the surrounding district there are a number of long established out door bowls clubs, but until comparatively recent times there were no indoor clubs in the whole of our County. Those bowlers who were keen to continue playing during the long winter months had to venture further afield to other counties.

I can remember an earlier Hon. secretary of our County once saying that to be successful, an indoor club had to be located where there were "enough chimneys".

Various attempts were made to start indoor clubs in Bucks and some reached fruition. We in this area were fortunate when a scheme aimed primarily at providing facilities for Paraplegics was embarked upon at Stoke Mandeville. Able bodied bowlers were allowed to play and some of us can recall those adventurous days when we first bowled indoors, actually in two converted hospital wards. Regular bowlers formed leagues and helped the Paraplegics and so indoor bowling in the Aylesbury area had made a start. Ultimately a proper indoor bowls building was completed. Membership from the surrounding area flourished and indoor bowling became well established. Members from out door clubs from quite a representative area around Aylesbury joined, and in fact quite a number of new bowlers, who had learned their bowls indoors, increased the total of those enjoying our sport.

We now have this new indoor club, Foxhill, gaining momentum in a remarkably short time. Credits and thanks to those concerned in getting things going are I hope fully documented elsewhere. We now anticipate, and fervently hope, that friendly and competitive bowls will continue to grow and expand in this area.

There are "enough chimneys" and surely there are also enough existing bowlers and potential new bowlers in the Vale to ensure that both Stoke Mandeville and our new Foxhill Club can enjoy a successful future. Both should be able to ensure this by encouraging membership and providing facilities compatible with that required for a flourishing and happy membership.

You, the bowlers, can each play your part both on and off the green. Its up to you all. Indoor bowling in Aylesbury and the surrounding area is now well established. Foxhill members will surely maintain this progress into the long term future.
