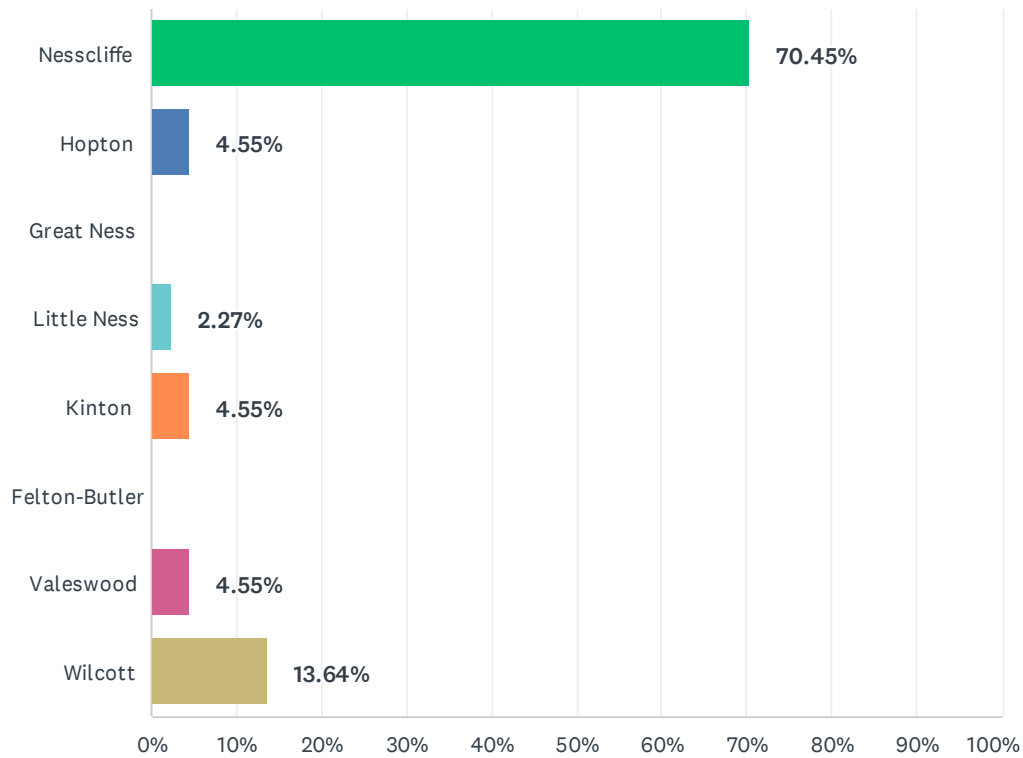
### Q7 If the playing field area was improved, are you more likely to use it?
