**(TEMPORARY 20 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION)  
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2025**

**Kent County Council works.**

To allow preservation works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to impose a temporary mandatory 20 mph speed restriction on part of A299 Thanet Way, Herne & Broomfield, Chislet & Birchington.

Restrictions are planned from 6th May 2025, with estimated completion by 21st May 2025, between the hours of 09:30 and 16:00, or where stated on valid permits. The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

The 20 mph speed restrictions on A299 Thanet Way will be imposed in both directions between the St Nicholas at Wade roundabout and the Eddington off slip, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The restrictions are required for the safety of the public and workforce while preservation works are undertaken by Kent County Council.
