	Step by the sheep stile near lychgate  Stone on floor as enter the main church	Gabbro???	People walking on it
	Stones around porch door & red stone around one window  Wall below south aisle window  Various	Sandstone Blue Lias Ironstone (Hornton)	Weather – rain washes away material that was holding the particles together &/or water in between particles expands as it freezes and breaks bits off
	Low white gravestone	Oolitic limestone	Weather and maybe plants roots or stems too
	South and south west facing walls, eg porch	Lime mortar between the white lias stones	Masonry bees Before the recent repairs some of the stone was so soft they made holes in the stone itself.
	Side of small chancel door	Sandstone	Probably weapon sharpening eg arrows Note in medieval times each village had trained archers. Often they practised in the churchyard on a Sunday (they worked other days).
