- 29/3/19 Bingo night.

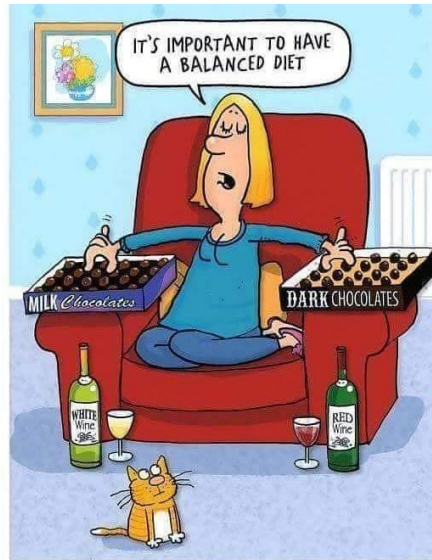
- 2/4/19 Trip to the National Arboretum.
