Priority	Initial actions 2015-16
1a (broadband)	RC: Collate broadband speeds for Harby (add article in newsletter) <i>by Feb 2016</i> .
1b (mobile signal)	RT: Join CLP working group for this issue and research options for residents such as booster boxes <i>by Mar 2016</i>
1c (more web content)	LS: release new website <i>by Jan 2016</i> and increase content <i>ongoing</i> .
2a (road and footpath conditions)	LS: information on website and newsletter on how to report defects <i>by Mar 2016</i> .
2b (speeding and parking)	Council: Liaise with the PCSO regarding community speed watch and use of the speed gun <i>by Apr 2016</i> .  Put up signs at cycle track regarding parking <i>by Apr 2016</i> . Continue to leaflet cars parked inconsiderately.
2c (gritting)	LS: Awareness campaign on local gritting and location of grit bins <i>by Nov 2015</i> .
2d (crime)	LS: Encourage reporting of all crime and ASB. Liaise with PCSO to confirm best way of reporting crimes and ASB <i>by Apr 2016</i>
3a (support CLP)	Offer support where possible to assist the CLP Steering group. <i>Ongoing</i> .
3b (planning)	Collate a summary of the CLP planning section to assist Councillors when being consulted on planning applications, <i>by Apr 2016</i> .
