It was agreed by the Parish Council on 8 January 2001, Minute number10.2 that a lease for the site of the new village hall was granted to the Village hall Management Committee. The lease was dated 24 January 2001 and is for a period of 99 years at a peppercorn rent. The Parish Council retained full rights of way, at all times, to the remainder of the playing field.
- 2 A right of way over Shortlake Lane, the road leading from the A353 to the above land. Deed of Grant dated 2 September 1965.
- 3 The leasehold interest in the land being part O.S. No. 7683 adjoining East Farm, Osmington, for use as an amenity area. The lease is for a period of 999 years from 24 June 1973 at a rent of one peppercorn per annum.
