

A resident complained about dog poo outside her property on the grass verge, they cleaned it up and have put stones on the verge to try and prevent it happening, this has occurred twice recently. ***The Village Voice have run an article on dog fouling, asking residents to keep their dogs on a lead and clean up after them throughout the parish.***

CCDC details of Local Council Reorganisation emailed to council 18th February 2026 ***We did agree that we (Cannock Chase) should be with Lichfield, so oppose the options which don't achieve that. The options which divide Staffordshire into a northern part and a southern part are better than the idea of a dividing line from North to South.***

SCC details of Cannock Chase Parish Forum emailed to council 18th February 2026.

A Councillor received a verbal concern from a resident about trees being surveyed in the area of Hollyhill Farm Holly Hill Road, they are concerned about the felling of trees which may affect the local wildlife and the privacy and security of their property. **We have spoken with the management of Beaudesert Trust, the surveyor was conducting an annual survey of the trees over the whole site to ensure safety. If needed the residents should contact the management of Beaudesert for more information if they are still concerned.**

Much of the land is Forestry Commission and is planted as a crop and therefore will be felled and replanted on a rotational basis.

- Footpath debris cleared and Cannock Chase District Council(CCDC) pressed into sweeping the roads and potholes, problem verges and flooding reported to Staffordshire Highways and bus timetables requested for bus-stops were missing.
- Took part in Bee-Squared with over 40 packs of wild-flower seed will be provided.
- Supported events open to all such as the spring event, emoji trail and photo competition.

- Responded to consultations on planning applications and the historic environment plan. Monitoring the on-going process for new unitary authorities as it impacts on Cannock Wood.
- Liaising with CCDC about management plan for Nunswell Park and South Staffs Water about the reservoir site.
- A new website www.cannockwoodparishcouncil.gov.uk developed compliant with accessibility requirements for Cannock Wood. Village events can be promoted on the website and the planning tracker automatically updates for local planning applications and offers single click through access to the detailed documents – if you take an interest in planning, take a look!
