Compton Parish Council are concerned at the lack of process and checking applied to this application by WBC Planning:

The site address for the application is incorrect which could possibly mis-inform those reviewing planning applications and may mis-represent the relationship of the applicant and those whose address has been used.

No orange planning notice has yet been displayed on/near the site.

Moving on to the application itself:

Compton Parish Council consider that the application for a new farm building should require prior approval of the Authority with regards to the siting, design and external appearance of this building.

The new farm building does not relate to the landscape setting and will have a detrimental impact on village settlement scene at the proposed location.

The preservation of the AONB remains of paramount importance to the Council, and it is important that the visual amenities of the AONB are not injured by proposals, which although not prejudicing the lands main purpose, might be inappropriate by reason of their siting, materials or design.

As a large single building, the proposal will have an unacceptable intrusive impact on the countryside in terms of:

- Structure size and scale in relation to the open lie (rise and fall) of the land.
- Build materials (concrete grey side panels) not harmonising to the surroundings.
- Associated increase in vehicular traffic within the vicinity and the possible overloading impact on the local bridleway and right of way network.

The application fails to provide clarification of the usage and therefore <u>need</u> for such a build at the site.
