A spokesperson for Frome Shed says, "Our space is also used for a wide variety of hand crafts such as macramé, machine sewing, banner making, knitting, painting, lino cutting - whatever the members want to do.

"If you fancy getting busy and creative in the evenings, or want to try new skills and interests, come along to the free open evening on Tuesday 8th February at 7 pm, have a look round, have a



cuppa and tell us what you would like to do.
