MotorX nuisance, Northampton Road/A508 Monitored by residents resulting in enforcement and ASB notices by SNC (Thanks to Cllr McCord for assistance), RoW enforcement issued to replace barbed wire used along footpath

Trees vs High sided vehicles Bridge Road > Cllr Roberts to inspect trees along boundary edge

Canal Bridge update (control still operates) pending CRT update on timescales, clerk to contact CRT requesting review of signage layout as concern regarding traffic queueing on bridge road and resulting congestion due to signs in road

Play Area > Q as to opening? Risk assessment circulated and discussed. > PC not happy to reopen due to the continued risk of contamination and concern over ability to safeguard users, situation to be reviewed at next meeting
