

Information available from Wartling Parish Council under the Freedom of Information Act model publication scheme

Under the model publication scheme Wartling Parish Council will make the following information available in order to meet its obligations, unless:

- It does not hold the information.
- The information is exempt under one of the FOIA exemptions or Environmental Information Regulations exceptions, or its release is prohibited by another statute;
- The information is readily and publicly available from an external website; such information may have been provided by the public authority or on its behalf. The authority must provide a direct link to that information;
- The information is archived, out of date or otherwise inaccessible; or,
- It would be impractical or resource-intensive to prepare the material for routine release.
