Morag Neeld confirmed that the poppy wreath had been picked up from the clerk and that it was not given to Patricia Spencer to take to the memorial service – it was noted that this should happen in the future and the card should say from the people of the village and supported by Suffield Parish Council

First Aid Course – Caroline Brett confirmed that this is due for renewal next year. She will get a quote from St Johns Ambulance for this. The clerk confirmed that she would also get a quote from Shepherds Health and Safety in North Walsham

Road surface outside the housed on Park View – It was agreed that an email would need to go to Victory Housing for them to deal with – The Clerk will action this

Suffield Charities – David Hawkins made the Parish council aware that there are 2 charities running in Suffield. The first being Lady Suffield Charity which helped to further educate Suffield Parishioners and

the second one was the Bulwer/Symonds Trust which purchased arable land and the rental income was to be distributed to widowed parishioners. It was discussed that Simon Evans from Irelands Land Agents manged the 3 pieces of land and David Hawkins would write to him to find out more details
