There were over 1000 responses in 6 weeks with 98% in favour of the pool.

The town has wanted a pool for a very long time - doctors, schools and businesses are in favour.

We have always said that we will be flexible with plans in order to achieve this goal. For example, in regard to Indoor rather than outdoor or changing the sizing.

We were in discussions with a private business concerning significant funding however without support from Breckland we could not take this any further. We would like to thank those who have been behind us this year, however it is essential that we have full backing from our Breckland councillors.

Without this, we cannot give our community this wonderful asset which they both need and desire"
