15 BROADBAND

Cllr M Lea tabled a report from Connecting Shropshire which details the new contract with Airband for the broadband rollout in Shropshire.

Cllr M Lea had been in discussion with Ben Walker from Connecting Shropshire to clarify position for Kemberton. Work on provision is scheduled and cabling works are planned over the forthcoming months.

The cabinet location is under review and may move to a more central location within village. Work is on track with anticipated rollout for Kemberton in phase 2 starting September 2017.

The Chairman tabled a copy of the parish plan for councillors to review. Cllrs J Rennison, G Giles and M Wright have been through parish plan and looked at various options for presenting data.

The Chairman **PROPOSED** that further discussion and adoption of parish plan should be deferred until next meeting to give councillors time to fully review.
