The Clerk will follow up the Chairman regarding the separate installation at the Red Lion pub and once completed, attention will turn to Lower Basildon.

The Council accepted cheque numbers 103608 – 103611 and the clerk confirmed the direct debit for SSE. The Clerk confirmed that cheque to bank balance checks have been completed without issue.

The Clerk presented the proposed 24/25 budget to the meeting and confirmed a figure of just over £1000 less than last year at £28,861 due to expected savings with electricity costs for street lighting and anticipated lower budget costs for grass cutting and gritting whilst other items remain broadly the same. The Council voted unanimously to accept the budget and the Clerk will request a precept of £23,000 from West Berkshire Council.
