## Wiltshire Council's Grass Cutting Policy

The clerk contacted Wiltshire Council to request that all our grass banks (apart from the Pigstrough verge) were cut earlier in the season in 2022 as it was felt that the large collapsing bracken decreased visibility and made the highways less safe. David Button (WC Area Highways Engineer) advised that the change in policy (to cut in the Autumn rather than spring) was implemented because of Head of Service and the then cabinet member for highways. The policy of delaying the cut until the end of the growing season was a general one covering the whole Wiltshire Council area and there was no option to request a change. David Button did say that if we submitted a marked map highlighting lanes to be treated as a priority, that he would try and arrange for them to be cut a little sooner in the growing season. The clerk submitted maps highlighting Milkwell, West End, Barkers Hill and the unnamed lane between The Haven property on Barkers Hill and Gutch Common.
