Much enjoyment was experienced by all and the standard of bowling was something that we able-bodied bowlers could only admire. Although tiring this proved to be a very worth while day - the pleasure derived from bowlers less fortunate than ourselves, left one with a feeling of delight and satisfaction. The bowls helpers had the pleasure of presenting the medals to the winners of the various sections.

RUSHMOOR INDOOR BOWLS CLUB

NAME - PREMISES & ADDRESS

The Club shall be called RUSHMOOR INDOOR BOWLS CLUB. FARNBOROUGH RECREATION CENTRE, FARNBOROUGH, HAMPSHIRE.

OBJECTS

The object of the Club shall be, in conjunction with the Farnborough Recreation Centre, to promote and further the game of Bowls and Social Activities between members themselves and members of other Clubs with similar objectives.

AFFILIATION

The Rushmoor Indoor Bowls Club shall be registered in due form with the E.I.B.A., E.W.I.B.A., and the Hampshire County Indoor Bowling Association.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership shall be open to Men and Ladies over the age of 14 years, independently of their membership of any other Club. Membership of Farnborough Recreation Centre is a prerequisite of Rushmoor Indoor Bowls membership and the appropriate fees must be paid annually as they fall due. The rules of conduct of the Farnborough Recreation Centre and the Rushmoor Indoor Bowls Club that may be in force or notified from time to time be observed and any member wilfully damaging property or contents belonging to either the Centre or the Club shall make good the same to the satisfaction of the Officers of the respective section.

OFFICERS Men's Section

The Officers shall consist of the Immediate Past President, President, Vice-President, Hon. General Secretary, Hon. Minutes Secretary, Hon. Treasurer, Hon. Competition Secretary, Captain, Vice-Captain, Hon. Match Secretary, Hon. League Secretary, Hon. Senior Green Steward, Hon. Hampshire County and Patrons Representatives and Centre Management.

Ladies Section

Immediate Past President, President, Vice-President, Hon. Secretary, Hon. Treasurer, Hon. Competition Secretary, Hon. Match Secretary and Centre Management.

SECTION COMMITTEES

The Men's Section Committee shall consist of the Officers plus three additional members. The Ladies Section Committee shall consist of the Officers plus two additional members.

These Committees shall hold as many of their own meetings, during the season, as they deem necessary. A quorum shall consist of 11 Men or 6 Ladies of their elected committees. Said Committees may call a full meeting of their own respective members at any time.

All Officers and Committees with the exception of the Centre Management, to be elected at their respective General Meetings to be held in April.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The Executive Committee shall consist of the Immediate Past President, President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer of the Men's and Ladies' Sections, the Mens Minute Secretary and Match Secretary - and 5 other members (2 of whom shall be ladies) all to be elected at the Annual General Meeting held in April. Two members of the Centre Management will also sit on the Executive Committee. The Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer of the Executive will be elected at the first/ convened Executive Meeting after the Annual General Meeting. This Committee shall meet at least 4 times a year (September - December - February - April) 10 Members

shall form a quorum of the Executive Committee and shall have power to co-opt additional member/s and may appoint such sub-committees as it may consider necessary.

FINANCE

All matters affecting the income and expenditure of the Club will be controlled by the Executive Committee and/or by a special finance sub-committee as determined by the Executive Committee.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

- The Annual General Meeting for all members shall be held in April of each year to receive the reports of the Executive Committee and the presentation of the Accounts for the preceding year duly audited by the Borough Treasurer, as well as a statement of the Current Years financial situation prior to audit. To consider any proposals for alteration of Rules. 35 members shall form a quorum. Any two members of the Club may nominate a member to serve on the Executive Committee (2 of whom must be Ladies). All Club members shall be entitled to vote. All such nominations must reach the Executive Secretary at least 21 days before the date of the Annual General Meeting and all nominated persons must have agreed, in writing, to stand. A printed list of the names of the candidates will be distributed to each member present at the Annual General Meeting who will place an X against the name or names for whom they wish to vote. Propositions shall be decided by a show of hands, or ballot if requested by a member. Any vacancy occurring during the year may be filled by a person as agreed by the Executive Committee. The date of the Annual General Meeting must be notified on the Club Notice Board at least 28 days prior to the Meeting and the Agenda must be exhibited on the notice board at least 7 days prior to the Meeting.
- If the quorum is not reached a second date for the Annual General Meeting will be arranged. If at that second meeting the quorum is still not reached the Executive Committee will have the power to make the appropriate decision.

SPECIAL MEETINGS

A Special General Meeting will be called by the Executive Secretary within 21 days of a written request signed by not less than 15 members stating the nature of the business they wish to discuss. Notice of the Agenda will be posted on the notice board at least 7 days prior to the Meeting. 35 members shall form a quorum.

If the quorum is not reached rule 2 above applies.

EXTRAORDINARY OR EMERGENCY COMMITTEE MEETINGS

The Executive Committee has the power to call an Extraordinary or Emergency Committee Meeting at any time.

ALTERATION TO RULES

A Rule may only be altered or rescinded by a resolution passed by two thirds of the members present and voting at an Annual General Meeting or Extraordinary Meeting called for that purpose, of which notice of the intention to propose the resolution has been duly given to the Executive Secretary, in writing, for the inclusion on the Agenda of the Annual General Meeting or Extraordinary Meeting.

PUBLICATION OF CONSTITUTION AND RULES

The Constitution and Rules of the Club shall be exhibited on the notice board of the Indoor Club and on joining the Club every member shall be furnished with a copy of the Constitution and Rules of the Club.

RULES OF PLAY

CONDUCT

All Members will observe, at all times, rules of conduct and play that are displayed.

NOTICES

All notices placed on the notice board during the season shall be deemed sufficient intimation to all members.

DRESS

All players must wear smooth rubber soled heel-less footwear and will wear white above the waist with the exception of Club Matches when all whites will be worn. Men will wear Club ties for friendly matches. Ladies may wear club colours, as approved by their Committee, for league games and their own Club Matches.

COMPLAINTS

Complaints shall be sent in writing to the Hon. Executive Secretary for the Committee's consideration.

HOURS OF PLAY

Details of session times and matches will be shown on the Club notice board and published on a fixture card of league and match programmes.

CONTROL OF PLAY

The Green Steward will ensure that green fees are paid on issue of match card. He will also reallocate any available rinks.

Non-members will be accepted to take part in sessions upon payment of the required green fee to the Green Steward, but will not be permitted to play in preference to members, when sufficient members are wishing to play. Non-members will only be allowed two visits in any one month during Club time.

During Ladies sessions Ladies will have complete priority of green occupation but should there be insufficient ladies present they may either include men in their rinks or any available rinks may be occupied by men. During Men's sessions a similar arrangement for the ladies will prevail. Mixed games may be arranged.

LEAGUE AND COMPETITION RULES

- 1 Any person playing in the league or competitions must be a member of the Farnborough Recreation Centre and the Bowling Club.
- 2 All leagues are of 18 ends or 2 hours duration, with the exception of Two-Wood triples which is 21 ends or 2 hours duration.
- 3 In all league games the jack shall be delivered not placed. If, however the jack is delivered out of the rink the opposing skip has the right to place the jack. If, during play, the jack is put out of the rink one shot is added to the non-offending side and counted an end played.
- 4 In a mixed league team at least one playing member must be of the opposite sex.
- 5 A league match may be postponed by mutual consent provided at least 48 hours notice is given so that the rink will be available for other players. If no such notice is given the green fees must be paid by the offending side. The game must be re-arranged, though not necessarily played, within 14 days. In extenuating circumstances, three members of the Executive Committee, in mutual agreement, have the power to rescind the 48 hours time limit.

6 If play is stopped because of an emergency outside our control, the result will stand if 5 or more ends have been played.

7 The bell will be rung 5 minutes before the end of the session after which no further end may be commenced.

8 Owing to the great cost of the indoor jacks it is the responsibility of the skip to return the jack and to put the completed score card in the envelope provided.

9 National Competitions will take priority, so it may therefore be necessary to change league or other games to another rink, and it is hoped all players will co-operate if the occasion should arise.

10 Captains are to notify the Hon. Secretary of any additions to their playing strength not on the original league registration list.

CLUB COMPETITION

11 Rules 1 and 5 above apply

12 Singles: 21 shots or 2 hours duration. Semi Final and Final played to finish. If jack sent out of rink end to be re-played. Winner and Runner-up qualify for County Singles last eights.

13 Pairs - Triples - Rinks. Games to be of 18 but not less than 15 ends or 2 hours duration. Rule 3 applies. Finals - 3 hours time limit is only restriction, otherwise play to completion. Rules 3 does not apply. Winners of Pairs qualify for County Pairs quarter finals.

COUNTY COMPETITION

14 Rules 1 and 5 above apply

15 Triples and Rinks - as for Club Rules 13.

16 Senior Two-wood Triples - 21 Ends or 2 hours duration. Semi-Final and Final - play to competition.

NATIONAL COMPETITIONS

17 Rules 1-5 and 9 apply

LEAGUE SUPERVISORS DUTIES

On the first week collect the League Registration Forms and Fees from each Captain or Skipper. i.e. £6 per team. The fees and Registration Forms to be passed to the League Secretary.

On League evenings, after each game, collect the score cards from each Captain. Record each of the scores on the appropriate League Chart. In Red for a win Green for a draw and Black for a loss.

Every Fourth week insert the loose strip card showing the League position of each team.

The recorded score cards should be fixed together and filed in the appropriate box file which is stored in the Club cupboard.

In the event of a fixture not being fulfilled, ensure that the game has been re-arranged according the Clubs "Rules of Play" Rules No. 5.

The score for the re-arranged game can be recorded in its original week's space and added to the cumulative total of the week recorded.
