The house on Pasture View is now deemed as dangerous NSDC are considering various actions.

A dip in the road surface on the A6097 near to Lowdhams entrance is making vehicles mistakenly think that oncoming traffic is flashing them to pull out. Drain on Peck Lane still no action by STrent – Main Street is a soakaway not a drain, Cllr Platten to provide photos. The broken safety rails adjacent to the slip road have still not been repaired and are a health and safety hazard. Concerns were again discussed about the buses using the slip road to exit Gunthorpe onto the A6097. The Parish Council asked Cllr Jackson if the new developments being planned at Bingham, Newton, Radcliffe and East Bridgford in the Rushcliffe Borough were taking into consideration the cumulative effect of increased traffic on the A6097 and its access roads.

09.06 Riverside Project, Gravel Extraction and Flood Alleviation

Trees for new wood to be delivered shortly it is planned to store them until the weather has improved, helpers required for digging holes and planting trees, woodland plan of species noted, it is planned to call the area 'Weaver's Wood'. Cllr Everington attended the drilling of bore holes to look for clay deposits that maybe suitable for the possible 'bund' at Lowdhams
