88/16-17 Welcome & Apologies

Clir Blaydes opened the meeting and explained the safety procedures. There were apologies from **Clirs Townend**, **Shonk and Lyon**.

89/16-17 Declarations of interest

Clir Hovenden & Clir Searle signed the book for item 97/16-17. **Clir Blaydes** proposed that Mr Small be co-opted onto the Council. Seconded **Clir Hovenden**, All in favour. **Clir Small** read the declaration of acceptance.

Clir Searle reported the bollard in the car park has been replaced.

Clirs Reports- Clir Blaydes confirmed he had attended flood warning seminar. He obtained some information regarding the flood risk of Cliffsend which will advise us where the flood risks are.
