CODE OF CONDUCT

As a member of this club, you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

1. All members must take responsibility in ensuring they are up to date with the Laws of the Game, understand and adhere to them.
2. All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
3. Members should recognise the valuable contribution made by coaches and officials who are usually volunteers. They give their time and resources to provide bowls for you. If a member is unhappy with a decision or a ruling they should follow the club's own or Bowls England guidelines on making a complaint
4. All members must respect officials and publicly accept their decisions.
5. All members should be a positive role model, treat other players, and officials with the same level of respect you would expect to be shown to you.
6. Use correct and proper language at all times particularly when playing mixed matches, competitions or roll ups and be aware of the sensitivities of the other players.
7. Members are not allowed to smoke, or vape within the Club premises.
8. Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
9. Members must wear suitable bowls footwear on the mat, as per the Association rules.
10. Bullying of any sort (physical, verbal or mental) will not be tolerated.
11. Encourage everyone to enjoy sport and understand that people have different motivations for taking part.
