

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT NOTICE, A353, POXWELL

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. The Notice comes in to operation on 18th May 2026 and will remain in force for 5 days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 22nd May 2026.

This Notice will provide Wessex Water with safe access to repair a highway defect.

The effect of this Notice is as follows:

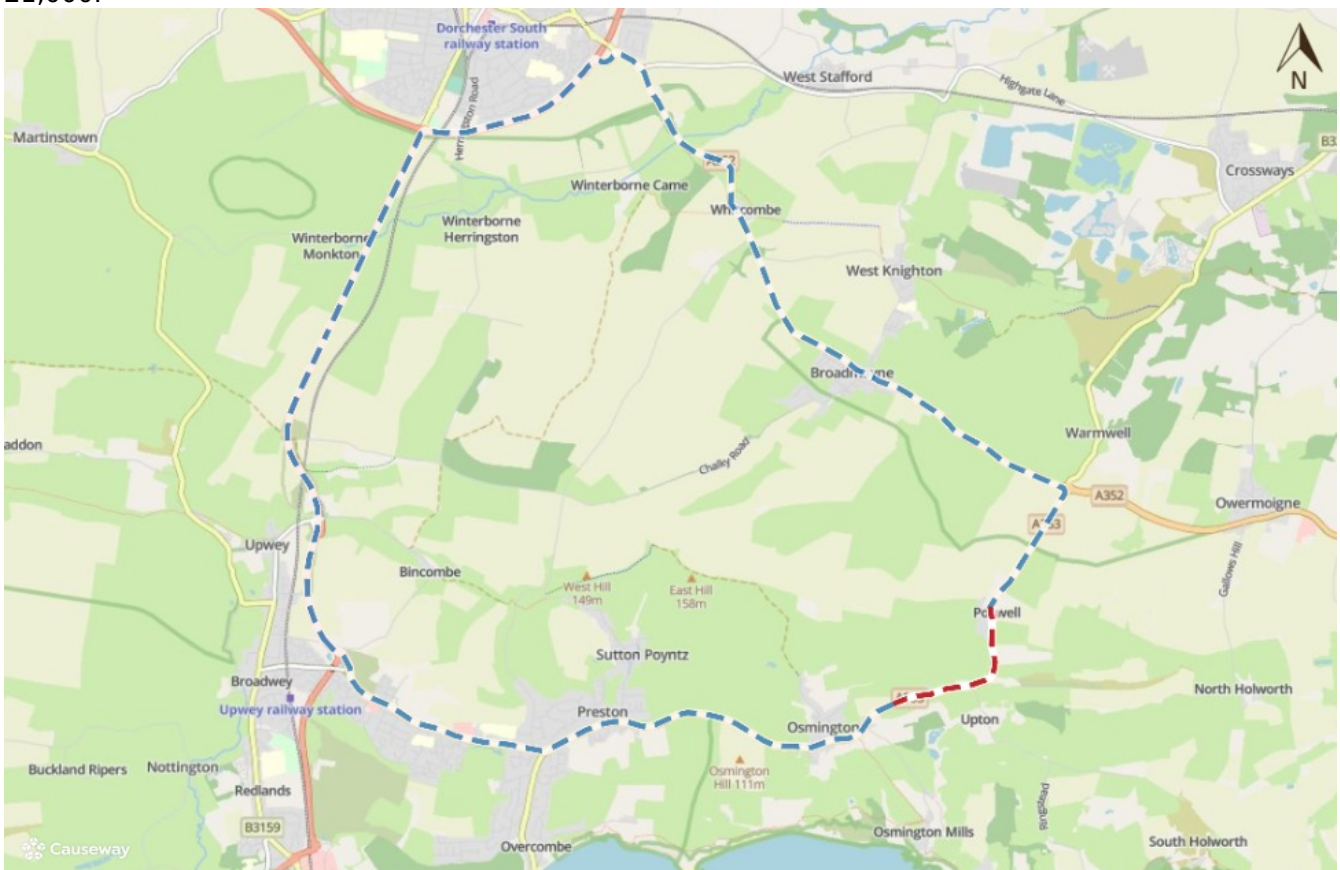
[1] To impose temporary road closure on A353, Poxwell from junction with Poxwell Drive to outside The Stables, Grove Hill, Osmington (in both directions), a distance of approximately 1680 metres. The road closure will be in operation overnight from 21:00 until 06:00, as indicated by signs on site. An alternative vehicular route will be signed using A352, A35, A354, A353 and vice versa.

[2] To impose temporary 30mph speed limit on A353, Poxwell from junction with Poxwell Drive to outside The Stables, Grove Hill, Osmington (in both directions), a distance of approximately 1680 metres. The temporary speed limit will be in place 24 hours a day, as indicated by signs on site.
