### 8 Allotments

Cllr Hughes has given up his allotment and it has been taken over by Mr Paul Clare. The tenancy agreement has been returned and we received the £3.00 rent on  $6^{th}$  September. Mr Clare has asked for permission to erect a shed (10' x 6') and poly tunnel (15' x 12). Approval was granted for both items, clerk to contact Mr Clare and let him know that when he finishes his tenancy they must be removed from site unless he negotiates something with the new tenant.

Cllr Brown gave Cllr Carlisle a key for the shed, another copy is to be given to Toby Leetham.

Clerk has contacted Nick about his allotment as it is covered in thistles, he wishes to keep it will sort it out soon.

Mr Todhunter has asked if we can chase up the Lords in Trust as it has been over a year since our last correspondence regarding the walls. Clerk to contact Mr C Raine to ascertain if any progress has been made regarding the repairs.

## 9 Play Park

Clerk to book an inspection at the cost of £195.00, approved by Cllr Brown, seconded by Cllr Carlisle.
