

KCC Report May 2026

Turner Contemporary Margate

KCC has welcomed a £865,000 funding award from the Arts Council England for Turner Contemporary in Margate.

This funding was secured through the Creative Foundation Fund as part of the Government's £1.5 billion Arts Everywhere Fund and is allocated for essential maintenance and capital works to protect the gallery's infrastructure and support its ability to host exhibitions to international standard.

Road to Remembrance Folkestone

KCC has moved a significant step closer to reopening one of Folkestone's most treasured historic routes, with the executive decision on the Road to Remembrance, now formally implemented, and preparations for on-site works underway.

For more than 2 years the road has been closed following a significant landslip

KCC engineers have spent that time overcoming repeated landslips and unstable geology, protected species and wartime infrastructure discovered within the cliff.

A 299 Thanet Way

KCC will be carrying out a series of planned resurfacing works along the A299 Thanet Way during June and July 2026

To ensure the works can be completed safely, night time road closures will be required while resurfacing takes place.

Once the resurfacing works are completed, and it is safe to do so, the temporary speed restrictions will be removed, and the road will return to the national speed limit of 70 miles per hour.
