FROM THE PARISH COUNCIL CHAIRMAN

Dear Parishioners

In the last newsletter I mentioned how little rain we'd had during the swelteringly hot summer but in the past month Oxfordshire has turned green once more. In fact, I've been trying to fix my faulty lawn mower to stay on top of the garden and have been collecting a vast number of apples.

Thanks to the hard work of the Orchard Group, I'm sure it won't be too many seasons before the watering parties and expert pruners will have to turn their attention towards vast crops of fruit from the parish trees.

The Parish Council met in September to pick up on an array of matters from the summer which you can read about on the community website. One thing that we are looking into is the installation of cameras at various points around the Parish that have been blighted by fly-tipping. My fellow councillor Louisa Vincent attended a course on CCTV and reported back to us at the last meeting.

There will be an opportunity for you to let us know what you think about this, but we definitely feel that the abandonment of an entire caravan on the Wheatley Road was the ultimate fly-tipping insult and merits further action to protect our parish from this ongoing problem. Our Village Hall is available to hire 7 days a week for all kinds of events, whether you are celebrating a birthday, holding a workshop or remembering a loved one.



FROM THE REVEREND CAROLINE KING

What is your church like? I'm often asked that question by people who usually haven't been to church for a while and perhaps they would like to start coming again. I usually answer that I hope we are a church where people find it easy to feel 'they belong'. As I have got used to spending more time in the parishes of this group, I have felt welcomed.

Some time ago I came across the following welcome notice; it has been circulating on social media. I think it originates from Coventry Cathedral. I very much hope we are this sort of church:

We extend a special welcome to those who are single, married, divorced, widowed, straight, gay, confused, well-heeled or down at heel. We especially welcome wailing babies and excited toddlers.

We welcome you whether you can sing like Pavarotti or just growl quietly to yourself. You're welcome here if you're 'just browsing,' just woken up or just got out of prison. We don't care if you're more Christian than the Archbishop of Canterbury or haven't been to church since Christmas ten years ago.

We extend a special welcome to those who are over 60 but not grown up yet, and to teenagers who are growing up too fast. We welcome keep-fit mums, football dads, starving artists, tree-huggers, latte-sippers, vegetarians, junk-food eaters. We welcome those who are in recovery or still addicted. We welcome you if you're having problems, are down in the dumps or don't like 'organised religion.' (We're not that keen on it either!)

We offer a welcome to those who think the earth is flat, work too hard, don't work, can't spell, or are here because granny is visiting and wanted to come to the Cathedral.

We welcome those who are inked, pierced, both or neither. We offer a special welcome to those who could use a prayer right now, had religion shoved down their throat as kids or got lost on the ring road and wound up here by mistake. We welcome pilgrims, tourists, seekers, doubters... and you!

It is always wonderful to be able to welcome you, Sunday service details are always in the Village Magazines and on noticeboards.

You are especially welcome to join us for Harvest on Sunday 5th October and early next month for the Service of Light on 2nd November at 3.00pm. Here we name and light candles for those villagers who have died in the last year and for loved ones we would like to remember.

The following Sunday 9th November is Remembrance Sunday when we gather around the war Memorial to remember those who died in war.

I do hope you can join us; a warm welcome awaits.



Ordering Repeat Prescriptions Please use the NHS App or log into your account on the NHS website. For more information on ordering, visit the 'prescriptions' page on our website.

Winter vaccinations from MHS and the NHS are available to provide protection against serious illnesses like flu and COVID-19. Vulnerable groups can have their vaccinations from 1st September and remaining eligible groups from 1st October. If eligible you will have been contacted by MHS to book your vaccines. To check eligibility, visit the MHS website.

Weight Loss Medication is in the news and GPs can now prescribe Mounjara, one of the leading drugs. Eligibility criteria are very strict. Only a very small number of MHS patients will be eligible and will be contacted directly by the Surgery.

Changes to the routine childhood immunisation schedule are designed to provide even better protection for babies and children. The recent rise in measles cases mean it is more important than ever to ensure your children's vaccinations are up to date.

Friends of All Saints Church

Keeping Cuddesdon's Heritage Alive



Tucked in the heart of Cuddesdon, our beautiful All Saints Church is more than just a striking landmark - it's a Grade I listed building with roots reaching back to 1180. Built on the foundations of an earlier 12th-century church, it has stood largely unchanged since the 13th century, with just a few later touches in the 14th and 15th centuries.



The Friends of All Saints Church (FOASC) are working to make sure this historic gem continues to serve the parish for centuries to come. Our first mission? To raise £25,000 to restore the lychgate at the churchyard entrance, which is now in urgent need of repair.

What is a Lychgate?

Our church's lychgate isn't just a pretty entrance - it's a medieval tradition with a very practical past. The word *lych* comes from Old English for "corpse," and these roofed gateways once sheltered coffins, mourners, and clergy as the first part of the burial service was read. They also marked the symbolic crossing from everyday life into sacred ground. Many lychgates disappeared with changing funeral customs, but in Victorian times they were revived for their charm—and after WWI, some became poignant war memorials. Next time you pass through, imagine the centuries of farewells it has witnessed.





FREE ELECTRIC BLANKET TESTING

With autumn and winter approaching, now is the perfect time to make sure you are ready for the colder nights ahead. Oxfordshire County Council is reminding residents about free electric blanket testing that is happening across the county

Last year, over 30% of blankets tested by the Council did not pass the safety check — so it is really important to have yours tested before winter.

Sessions are run by Oxfordshire County Council's trading standards team. Full addresses and time slots are provided when you book your appointment.

The nearest testing to us is taking place on Monday 6th October at Risinghurst in Oxford

Typhoid and Paratyphoid A Fever vaccine study: Volunteers wanted.

Help us make a difference to millions of people by joining our study.

If you are aged 18 to 55 years old, and in good health, you may be eligible to take part in the BiVISTA study to find a vaccine against typhoid and paratyphoid A fever.

Participants will be vaccinated with the new vaccine or control, and then exposed to the bacteria that causes paratyphoid fever. All study participants will receive antibiotic treatment.

All participants will be reimbursed up to £4585 for their time, inconvenience and travel.


