

Clerks Report for the Uffington Parish Council Meeting Monday 8th December 2025.

I am pleased to be able to report the following;

Residents Correspondence:

Correspondence was received relating to flooding at the Woolstone Road/Fernham Road area in particular and the current management of flood reporting. An agenda item has been included.

Burial Ground:

Contractor has been appointed to refurbish the notice board.

Defibrillators:

None of the units have required use and are all available for use.

Fix My Street: The following new reports have been registered.

A number of reports were made during the month, primarily relating to the ongoing Gigaclear works. While these are reported to OCC via the system they have also been forwarded to Gigaclear.

General:

A new savings account with Hampshire Trust Bank has been arranged and an initial transfer of £20,000.00 made. This will increase the savings income going forward.

The crown lift of the oak circle has been completed.

OCC have started repairs to the Shotover/High Street footpath.

The equipment relating to the allotments has now been obtained excluding the storage unit which is due to be delivered in January 2026.

While the sale of the Village Stores was delayed this is expected to reach completion prior to 1st December 2025.
