The issue of 'Ducks' has been on many an agenda at Town Council or Committee meetings in recent years. It is a difficult conundrum to resolve, as people either love or hate them. The Town Council have a contract with a pest control company in the Town for areas that they own or manage. We were ridiculed in the national press for trying to 'manage' the situation a few years back at our Market, so we do have to tread a very careful path, as we don't own public areas such as the Town Centre, and only manage this area on a Saturday with the Market. Some Councillors will always argue that it is not the Town Council responsibility, but the majority at present have agreed to try to help.


