

Shrawley Parish Council is one of 53 Parish Councils in Malvern Hills District. The Council have elections every 4 years for Councillors to represent the local community on the Local Authority.

The last elections in Shrawley were held in May 2015 when 7 local people were elected. On 2nd May 2019 all the seats on Shrawley Parish Council are up for election. Shrawley Parish need 7 local people to stand and represent the parishioners on the first tier of Local Government.

The Council hold meetings every second month during the year. They set a Precept (a proportion of your council tax bill) and have a legal responsibility to provide certain services and improvements for the betterment of its residents.

The Council are also consulted on all Planning Applications being considered by Malvern Hills District Council together with Consultations from Worcestershire County Council and other Local Authorities and Organisations. Both of Shrawley Parish Council's District & County Councillor's attend our meetings regularly to give updates on progress being made on the Principal Authorities.
