- 1. The Chairman, Cllr Liz Ellicott welcomed the public and opened the meeting.
- 2. Apologies for absence received from Cllr Funnell and Cllr C. Dunkley
- 3. The Chairman, Cllr Liz Ellicott delivered an Annual Report- A copy of the report is available from The Clerk on request.
- 4. WildChild Forest School An interesting report regarding the recent activities during School Holidays was delivered given by Lynne Lane. A copy of the report is available from The Clerk on request.
- 5. EMC Football Academy An outline of how The Academy is structured, who it is aimed at and how it runs was delivered by Jake Blackwell. Jamie McCloy gave an interesting insight into being a student who has benefitted and progressed through the academy to now being a member of staff.
- 6. Cllr Alex Britcher-Allen delivered a report on behalf of the Borough Councillors which included an outline the Parish Boundary review. Cllr Britcher-Allan outlined there is to be a reduction in the total number of parish councillors. 48 reducing to 39 in TWBC area.- approx. 1 councillor to every 2400 people.
