

## Handcross Bowls Club Competition Rules

- 1. All players must wear greys, as per normal match dress.
- 2. Score cards must be signed by both competitors.
- 3. Only Competition Committee Members to write results on competition sheets which should be placed in the appropriate box at the end of the match.
- 4. Fifteen minutes allowed waiting time.
- 5. All singles matches must have a marker.
- 6. The first named player in each round is the challenger. They are responsible for the match arrangements and providing the marker if it is a singles competition.
- 7. At the start of the competition and after the closing date of each round, the challenger must offer three dates to his/her opponent for the next game. If necessary one of these dates should be an evening or weekend.
- 8. If an opponent fails to play on the dates agreed then the match goes to the challenger.
- 9. If the challenger fails to make the arrangements for the match, then the opponent becomes the challenger and offers three dates for the match to take place.
- 10. Failure to play the match by the due date will result in the elimination of both competitors/teams from the competition.
- 11. No extensions after completion dates.
- 12. The rink must be shaken from the box immediately prior to the commencement of the match.
- 13. Players who know that they will be unable to attend Finals Day must not enter these competitions.
- 14. If during the season, a player finds that they cannot attend Finals Day they must immediately contact a member of the Competition Committee so that they can be taken out of the competition and adjustments made.
- 15. If a player finds himself or herself in more than two finals and is physically unable to play a third in one day then the Competition Committee must be informed, and the match played before Finals Day.
- 16. The Doran Shield is played as the best of 3 sets of seven ends. If the score is all square after the seventh end of the third set then an extra end must be played.
- 17. In the event of a dispute, please see a Competition Committee Member.
