

Clerks Report for the Uffington Parish Council Annual Meeting Monday 14th June 2025.

I am pleased to be able to report the following;

Residents Correspondence:

Correspondence has been received regarding the maintenance and responsibility of the Jubilee Field in areas neighbouring residents properties. Uffington Parish Council is responsible for this maintenance, however it should be noted that issues relating to branches overhanging into neighbouring properties are the responsibility of the property owner. Additional items mentioned in the correspondence received are currently under discussion by the Council.

Burial Ground:

No issues or items to report.

Defibrillators:

None of the units have required use and are all available for use.

Fix My Street:

The introduction of the 'Super User' has seen a large increase in the number of faults being recorded on the Fix My Street system. Those reports made by the Super User tend to show the faults highlighted by spray paint for differentiation.

General:

The ditch clearing exercise being conducted by Oxfordshire County Council has not yet commenced and due to an internal reorganisation of the relevant department the annual grass cutting donation has been delayed. (06/25.4.1)

Following advice giving to the Council regarding the Village Trail literature. Two new leaflet dispensers haven been acquired and an order made for a supply of up to date leaflets. (06/25.15.2)

Th repairs to the village car park exit have now been completed and safety markers are due to be removed. (06/25.11.2)



The new goal posts and Disc Golf nets have been installed on the Jubilee Field and notice given to residents if anyone would like to recycle the old goal post. (06/25.12.2, 06/25.12.3.a)
