Discussion	<p>There was a lengthy discussion about the re-submitted plans for the Prima site. A parishioner had been in contact with DDC planning and here are the main points discussed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> the public right of way referred to is across Easole St number EE312 and matters as from there you get a view of the proposed development (see footpath view, submitted 18 August) the amended plan allows a little more of the wall to be retained and seen. The view from publicly accessible spaces are important. "Fleeting" glances between houses less so. The "returns" at the wall ends are retained so the extent of the wall can be worked out in future (a reminder of what we would have lost?) underground archaeology has not been mentioned so far, KCC may or may not mention this in their response (so consideration in planning may depend on people writing in to emphasise that) the wall is a Non-Designated Heritage Asset and is partly in the conservation area (this part would be demolished) and a substantial "trackway" is also in and would be developed rights over the trackway are a civil matter and not considered by planning (suggested people look at their deeds) planners do consider "residential amenity" and the density, size and character in the context of the surrounding area previous comments stand but more are welcome. It is helpful if they are not repetitive and to the point <p>All previous comments made to DDC would still be relevant but it would do no harm to re-iterate them to DDC before 26th September.</p>

The Council decided that a No Dogs policy was the correct way to go and the new signage would be removed. Policing of this would have to be by the Parish Council.
