

Notification by a member of APPLETREEWICK PARISH COUNCIL of disclosable pecuniary interests (2021)

All councillors are required to provide a record of their interests in a public register of interests. This must be completed within 28 days of taking office. The general public and fellow councillors need to know which of your interests might give rise to a conflict of interest. This helps to preserve public confidence in the integrity of local government.

Connections include:

- Membership of local authority bodies
- Membership of any body exercising functions of a public nature – trade union or political party.
- Your Job/ business and that of anyone who lives with you
- Any land or property in the PC area

Interests are anything that will affect the well-being, or financial position of you, members of your family or people with whom you have a close association – is likely to be affected by the business of the meeting MORE than it would affect MOST people in the area.

Prejudicial interests may also “colour” your decisions – for example:

- The matter being discussed affects your financial position or that of any person with whom you have a personal interest
- Where a member of the public who knows the relevant facts would reasonably think your personal interest is so significant that it might prejudice your judgement.
