- b) **Medway Local Plan** Next stage will be Draft Local Plan for consultation in June/July 2019 (delay from January/February 2019 after HIF bid response) No further update. Medway are looking to spend £86m on alternative road access, £67m on a railway station and rail service and the remaining £17m on general community infrastructure Government

There has been concern expressed to CPA about the works carried out in the temporary changing rooms and the trenching for water and electricity supplies – now will be replaced by permanent construction as part of improvement works.
