

MALTHOUSE WELL

We've had around 70mm (3in) rain for December which is in its typical range and less than we received in October and November where we had around 100+mm (4in) each month. This means we've had the wettest Autumn since 2013 and as a result the ground water is rising rapidly. The Malthouse Well reading now stands at approximately 11.0 metres (36ft) below ground level. This is shown in the graph below which also shows that the groundwater is now at a similar level to December 2013 which preceded the 2014 floods. We still have some way to go before any flooding occurs, but a lot of heavy rain in January could make things interesting. For those who want to track this more closely the PVFF website
