2299. PARISH MATTERS.

2299a. Ball Court - the clerk had spoken to Mr Pete Tipton and asked him to sweep the surface of the ball court. The chairman had spoken to him about drainage around the ball court and Mr Tipton had submitted an estimate of £370 to prevent muddy water running onto the court during heavy rainfall. **Councillor A Richards proposed and councillor P Bodimeade seconded that the Council accept this estimate and Mr Tipton be asked to complete the work after consultation with Councillor McFarland.**

2299b. Mr Ian Pennington had approached Councillor McFarland about the visibility at the corner at the cross roads at Butchers Barn. Councillor MacFarland had arranged a meeting on site with Mr C Jackson and Mr G Shaw to discuss the problem..

2300. WALL BANK SPEED LIMIT.

Following the analysis of speeds from the cables across the road Mr Shaw was speaking to Brian Williams, police liaison officer, about the possibility of putting a 40 mph sign before the houses on Wall Bank.

2301. THE NARROWS, RUSHBURY ROAD.
Mrs J:Kohn had contacted Councillor McFarland and had offered a small strip of land for the Council to provide a small verge for people to step off this narrow piece of road. The clerk was asked to write to the Divisional Surveyor with all the relevant information and hopefully he will be able to carry out the necessary work.

Mr R knight, Countryside Maintenance Manager, had contacted the council with regard to replacing the footbridge on footpath 278 with a wooden footbridge. It appears that the landowners are not happy with this alternative and Councillor Stevenson suggested that he and Councillor McFarland should meet Mr Knight on site with the landowners to discuss the way forward.
