8 Allotments

We have received a reply from Charles Raine, he has been forwarded the e-mails we sent to Richard Wilson who raised the matter at a recent Trustees meeting. The Lords in Trust do not consider the agreement we have entered into, or any part of it, to be invalid and they do not agree to the suggested rent reduction. They have asked that we continue to pay the rent agreed based on the recent agreement. It was also noted on a recent visit that the Client Field is not let by the Parish Council and the allotments are in a dilapidated state. If the land is not required than it should be surrendered back to them.

We would like to know the reasons why you disagree with the principles in the Grayston Webster award that your chairman agreed was a legal document and that also establishes your own rights and your existence.

The Clint **West** field is let for 3 years and any the one unkempt allotments will go to the next people on the list if the occupier does not cultivate it properly.
