Empty Salt Bins at Norton have been reported to KCC

KCC closed part of Lewson Street to traffic on 12th Jan for approximately three hours. No prior warning was given to the Parish Council by KCC

Openreach have advised that there will be a temporary road closure at Lower Road Buckland on 26th March 2026

A KCC inspector has contacted Forge House in Worlds End regarding their hedgerow overgrowing into the road which is blocking driver's visibility. He requested that they cut the hedgerow back

An urgent road closure will take place at Lower Norton Lane 11th December 2025
