Roads and Flooding

The Parish Council has been liaising with the Highways Authority and relevant landowners regarding the road flooding at Westway Cross, Doctor's Corner and to the rear of Eastwick Barton. The drains at Westway Cross have collapsed; we await a repair date.

The need for road repairs by the bridge near Millbarn Cross was highlighted and the repair works have now been completed.

Public Rights of Way

An application for a new bridleway along Westcott Lane connecting to the existing Washford Pyne bridleway was rejected by Devon County Council and has also been refused on appeal by the Planning Inspectorate.

Thelbridge Parish Hall

The Parish Hall is managed by a charity. The Parish Council was able to provide some financial support for improvements to the kitchen and windows.
