Allotments - the main sites have been cleared as the holder has been unwell and unable to continue, there are now 3 plots to let, interest has been shown by 2 people

Drains ongoing – will be rectified sooner rather than later. Eon and N&SDC have a legal obligation to make good

Final thanks were given to the Village Hall Committee, the Vice – Chairman, the clerk and the Financial Officer – Mrs Rickett

Open Meeting

It was asked did the PC underwrite the Bomber Memorial - it done by Mr Paris

The question was raised about new build in the Village – it was explained that with the change to planning law and the Sustainability plan, that only necessary planning would be allowed i.e. agricultural dwellings, also there are approx 10 outstanding planning permissions for new dwellings
