

Cranleigh Bowling Club “Club Competitions By Laws” May 2016.

Dear All

As a reminder, postponement of any match will only be permitted for exceptional reasons with the agreement of the Competition Secretary, Sub-Committee and opponents, and only providing that such postponement does not cause delay in the next round of the competition.

Competition Bye-Laws

General

a) The first named player in the published tournament lists shall be regarded as the Challenger, the second named being the Opponent. It shall be the duty of the challenger to offer his or her Opponent three dates to play the match, one of which shall be a weekday unless the opponent is agreeable to 3 weekend dates.

The Challenger shall contact his/her Opponent at least 15 days before the end of round date, in the present case the 26 June, so please make contact before 11 June.. If that date passes with no contact, it will become the Opponent's responsibility to offer 2 dates, one of which shall be a weekday.

b) In the event of neither Challenger nor Opponent having made any attempt to arrange and play the match within the specified time limit then both players shall be regarded as being withdrawn from the Competition and the eventual next round Opponent shall be given a Bye into the following round.

c) In the event of one or other players concerned not being at the Green ready to play on the agreed date and within 30 minutes of the agreed time then the match will be forfeited to the player who has appeared.

Should neither player appear on the agreed date and within time then Rule 1b shall be enforced.

d) For the purpose of the Pairs and Triples Tournaments the foregoing rules shall be read in the plural sense.

e) With the exception of the Men's and Ladies Singles all Competitions shall be mixed.
