Bilsthorpe Village Hall on Cross Street is a community building in need of refurbishment. The Parish Council would like to push ahead with this plan and are keen to get residents' views and ideas to help this happen. The Village Hall was built in approximately 1930, as a village asset for mine workers, by the Stanton Ironworks Company. The Parish Council want to preserve the history and engineering that is unique to the building. We feel it's important for this building to be used by residents and become a central hub for the village as it used to be many years ago. Parish Councillors will be at the Village Hall on Saturday 10th November between 2pm and 4pm to discuss these plans and listen to your ideas and comments.
