Dear all

Apologies for the long silence over the Summer. It seems as though we all went into hibernation!

I have – just now – chased Martin Cook (see below), for an update on where we are with things so we can get moving. I have also emailed Og St A, Chilton Foliat and Aldbourne parish clerks, to pick their brains on the installation and cost of Speed Indicator Devices (SIDs).

It might be that we don't pass the 'eligibility criteria' for getting a SID installed before the bridge, as you come down the hill from Aldbourne... But there are ways round this, and we could go ahead and install it ourselves. The document on SIDs published by Wiltshire Council states:

The Town and Parish Council's may, at their discretion, choose to add sites that have been subject to an automatic traffic count but that do not meet the eligibility criteria to the SID deployment list. It will be for the Town and Parish Councils to decide if the SID deployment is justifiable in these circumstances. However, use of SIDs at sites where there is no speeding problem is not encouraged as this may impact on the availability and frequency of deployment at those sites with a speeding problem and lessen the overall impact that SIDs are intended to have.

I will keep you posted. In the meantime, here is the document as it gives useful information on the Community Speed Watch process, which I know you were looking into Wilf. https://cms.wiltshire.gov.uk/documents/s97175/App1%2016-15.pdf

I would like to propose a Transport Working Group meeting, so we have a date we can all work towards. The next parish council meeting is 10^{th} November (after tonight) so maybe we could have one in the middle of October, so we can all report back on where we are – and hopefully we will have heard back from Martin Cook by then.
